- Exhibitions about the prehistory of Greater Poland and the beginnings of the Polish state • The African collection – papyruses with hieroglyphs, statues of gods and animal mummies! • An impressive courtyard with the only obelisk of Ramses II in the country • Little Explorer Points: you can dig up a skeleton, try on a helmet or put together a puzzle • A multisensory tour route.

- An audio guide for children

- Videomapping, 3D animations, presentations, games and films
- A play corner with wooden toys and games, an archaeological sandpit, a model of a castle
- Workshops, field games, educational weekends.

- Active exploration of the exhibition: trying on costumes, jigsaw puzzles, guessing games
- Interactive information boards and games
- A room dedicated to King Przemysł II, with a hologram of the ruler's seal
- A panorama of the historic part of Poznań from the viewing terrace on the castle tower.

- The story of the more than 100-year journey to independence • Staging of period interiors, domestic scenes and battlefield scenes (crossing a trench from World War I) • Militaria (weapons, uniforms) • Films, photos and recordings – e.g. reports from the front to listen to on an old telephone • Costumes to try on: insurgent uniform, nurse’s outfit.

A real time machine: a museum journey to the time of the first mass protest of workers against the communist regime in Poland

- Entrance hidden between the numbers of the date 1956
- From a workers' flat to a factory to an interrogation room
- A model of a tram (which you can enter) and a tank
- A gallery of propaganda posters
- Stories of children – participants in the events of Poznań June
- Curiosities to discover: exhibits in the floor, photos in the peephole, recordings on the radio and... in a prison cell mug.

A treat for military enthusiasts: the extensive collection of weapons at the former Winiary Fort

- An open-air military equipment park in the Citadel Park: military vehicles, aircraft, helicopters, guns and mortars, among the exhibits a Katyusha rocket launcher and a T-34 tank
- An exhibition in the former gunpowder laboratory: a collection of weapons from all over the world, uniform silhouettes of Polish military formations that took part in the battles for Poznań
- A statue of Corporal Wojtek, a bear-soldier during World War II.





- An intimate museum presenting exhibits from one of the largest private collections of 19th-century dresses in Poland
- The most interesting exhibits: a summer dress from the 1840s, a dress from 1840 with a decoration of fake buttons, an evening dress from around 1880 from the department store B. Altman
- Lectures, demonstrations and thematic tours
- Regular changes of the exhibitions presented.





A journey into the past: a child's world from years ago

The billy goat doesn't know how to get out of the Town Hall tower. Can you help him find the way?



The Legend of the Poznań Billy Goats



In 1551, when Poznań Town Hall was being rebuilt, a great feast was due to take place in the celebration of installing a new clock on its tower. For this special occasion, many notable and honourable guests were to arrive, including the governor and his wife. It is small wonder that the food served at the feast had to be special as well. The piece de resistance was to be the leg of roe deer, prepared by master chef Mikołaj himself. All went very well in the kitchen, until the leg slipped off the spit, straight into the fire. The chef was devastated! However, one of the kitchen boys decided to find new meat for the roast. Unfortunately, roe deer was impossible to come by in the city, but he did manage to bring two white billy goats into the Town Hall kitchens. The animals, suddenly aware of their fate, tore away from the kitchen boy and escaped all the way up the tower. And as the guests were about to admire the new clock, their eyes were met with a very uncommon sight – two little white billy goats, butting their heads joyfully on the cornice of the town hall tower, causing general merriment. To commemorate these events, the mechanism of the tower clock was expanded with the metal figurines of two billy goats butting heads.
